INTRODUCTION

Your team will be tasked with the challenge of creating the next big Sci-Fi & Fantasy board game. The winner of this competition will be chosen by a distinguished panel of SFFHOF Inductees (Mr. B), along with master Sci-Fi & Fantasy gamers from across the nation (Room 78, aka Platte's Orphans).

The team that proves victorious will win the coveted SFFHOF "Clucky" award, aka, "The Clucky". "The Clucky" was eponymously named after the legendary Claire "Clucky" McCluskey, the founder and first inductee (self-nominated) into the Science Fiction & Fantasy Hall of Fame, creator of the SFFHOF Board Game Games, and heiress to the McCluskey Chevrolet dealership in Cincinnati, Ohio (<https://www.mccluskeychevrolet.com/>). Additionally, the winning team will be asked to serve on a panel of judges on ESPN 8's "The Ocho," to choose the winner of the annual Hip Hop Bag Pipe World Championships. Game Design Parameters (Essays and Projects Category = 65 POINTS)

15 points – Illustrated game board, die/dice, cards, game pieces/characters

15 points – Narrative introduction to the world the game exists within (300-500 words)

10 points – Instruction manual (how to play)

10 points – Game is designed around a story or film we read or watched in class

10 points – Can be played in 30 minutes

5 points – 3 or more players, ages 13 and up
