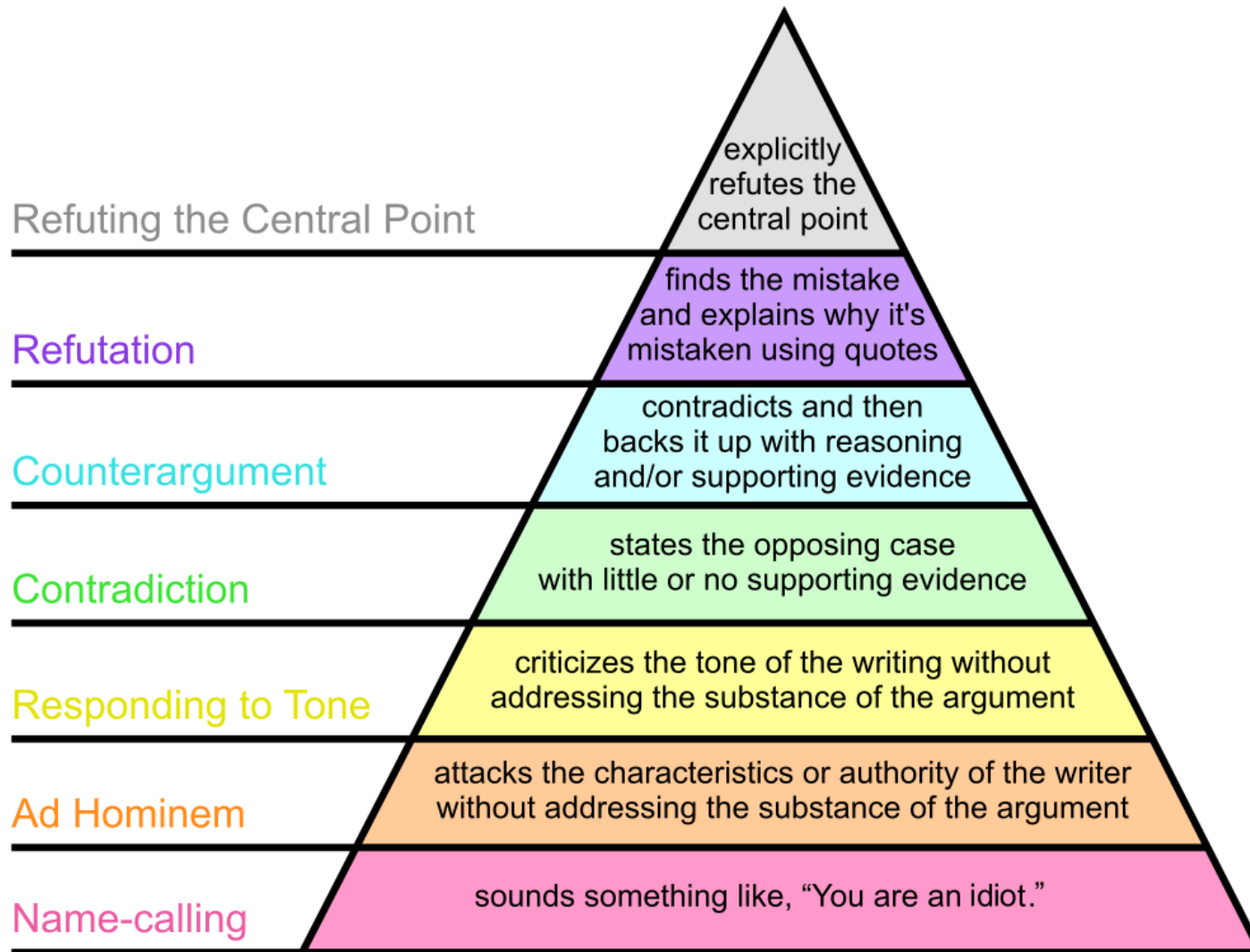
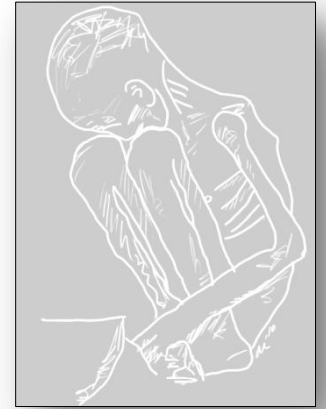


Graham's Hierarchy of Disagreement
